Clarify Decision Rights

Tool: RACI Snapshot

- ✓ Outline who's Responsible, Accountable, Consulted, and Informed for one project or process.
- Eliminates confusion and speeds decisions.

 **Suggested Visual:** 2x2 RACI grid or role map.



Launch a Leadership Dashboard

Tool: 5-Metric Tracker with RYG Definitions

- ✓ Select five strategic indicators and assign red/yellow/green thresholds.
- Creates alignment and sharpens focus.

 **Suggested Visual:** Color-coded dashboard sample.



Run a Micro Feedback Loop

Tool: Start / Stop / Continue Prompt Sheet

- ✓ Use this in a quick team or 1:1 session to surface actionable insights.
- Builds trust and opens real conversations.

 **Suggested Visual:** Sticky-note or dialogue layout graphic.



Map Your 90-Day Focus

Tool: Focus Map Template

- ✓ Define 3–5 short-term goals with owners and success signals.
- Restores clarity and guards against drift.

 **Suggested Visual:** Timeline or priority card layout.



Define “What Good Looks Like”

Tool: Outcome Clarity Checklist

- ✓ Set expectations and success signals for one role, project, or deliverable.
- Prevents misalignment and second-guessing.

 **Suggested Visual:** Checklist or clarity card format.



Simplify a High-Friction Process

Tool: Mini SOP Builder

- ✓ Break down a messy workflow into 5–7 clean, repeatable steps.
- Cuts waste, clarifies ownership, reduces rework.

 **Suggested Visual:** Before/After workflow sketch.



Set a Weekly Tactical Rhythm

Tool: Ops Sync Agenda

- ✓ Launch a brief weekly check-in with a clear agenda and issue triage.
- Improves visibility and keeps things moving.

 **Suggested Visual:** Agenda card or team sync icon.



Build Your Leadership Canvas

Tool: 1-Page Self-Reflection Template

- ✓ Capture your values, strengths, and leadership focus on a single page.
- Anchors decisions and clarifies personal style.

 **Suggested Visual:** Introspective worksheet or compass-style graphic.
